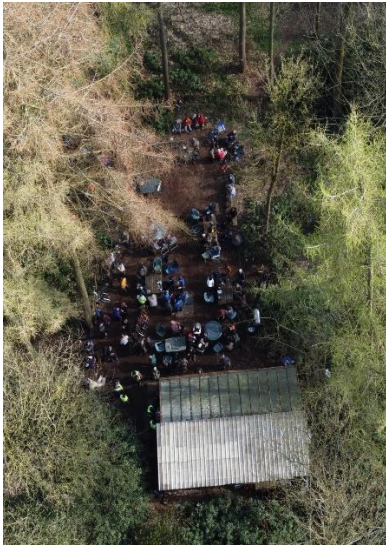


April Shoot Report
