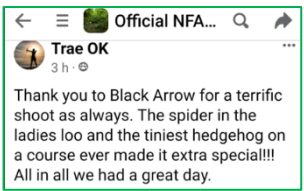


Like the new Hedgehog **wasp** peg at 20, which looked insignificant and a tiny globule is the Hedgehog!!!

Never seen a wasp peg that close! and err....., I can hardly see it!



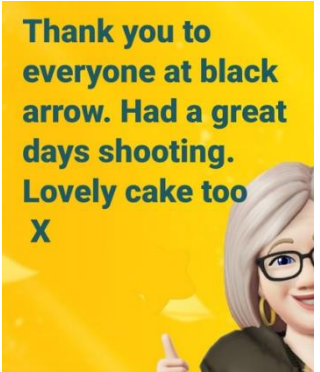
We like to have a laugh here and a large fake spider was put in the ladies' toilets, our joker Wayne can't help himself.
